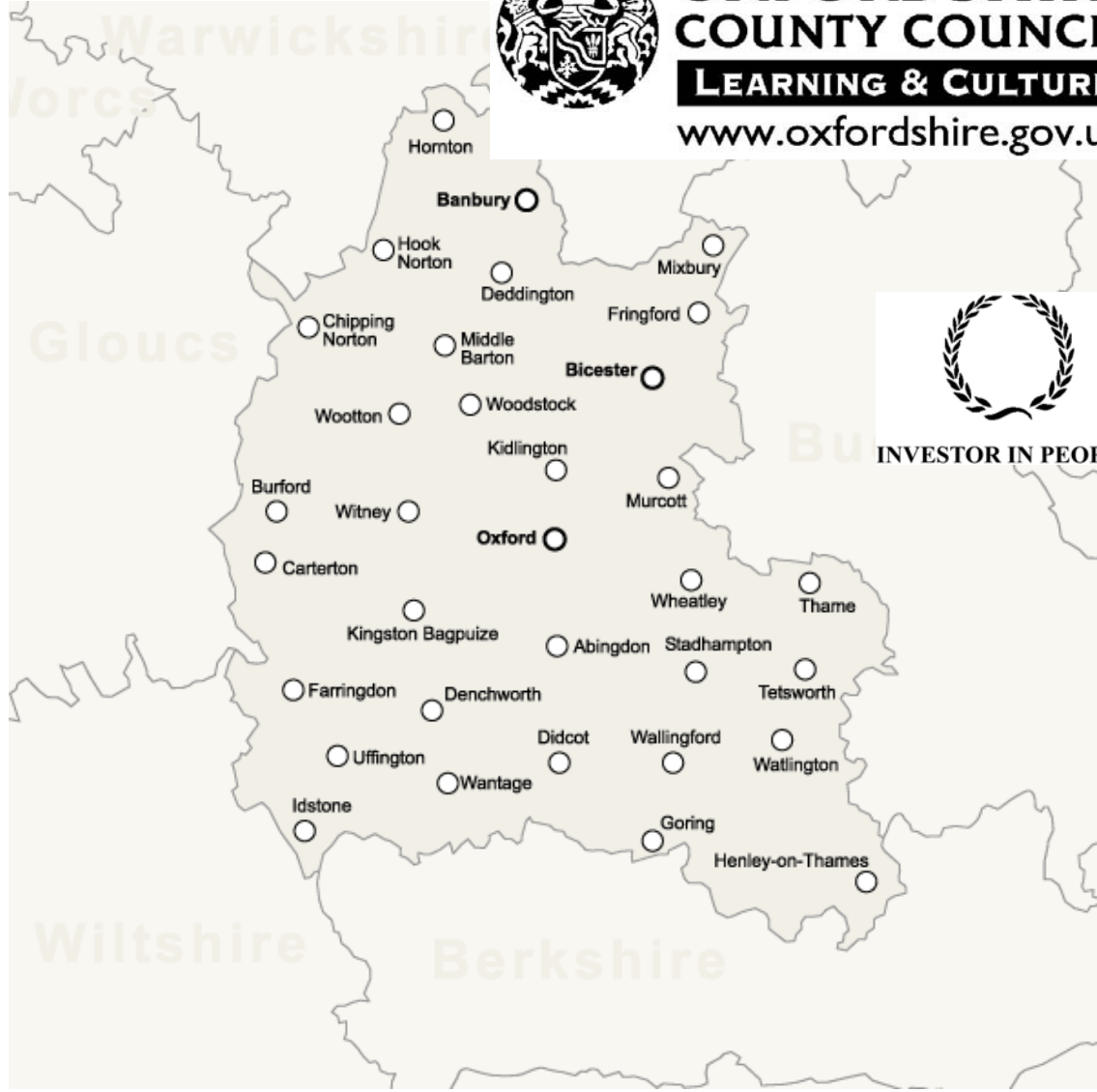

Introduction

This directory complements the information you have about provision for training and consultancy available through Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) and Oxfordshire Quality Schools Association (OQSA).

One of the frequent requests we receive from schools or teachers is about possible sources of consultancy and trainers, particularly in areas beyond immediate local providers. This directory aims to provide a worthwhile starting point for self-help with such enquiries. It does not claim to be comprehensive. Many of the providers have been used by OCC or OQSA, as indicated, (marked OQSA/OCC ✓) and we intend to gradually quality assure the list through OQSA quality assurance procedures and through feedback from users, and to extend OCC/OQSA usage of external as well as internal consultants.

We have not been able to include costs, as these are variable and often individually negotiated. Typically the range for a day's consultancy is from £250 - £1,000. Please obtain further details, including costs, through the contact information provided here.

We hope that you will find information has been organised in this booklet for easy reference and use. It will be placed on the intranet and updated periodically for future use. We welcome feedback, suggestions, and additions.
