Non-members can also take advantage of all that OIEB has to offer, but not the discounts, which make membership so cost effective!



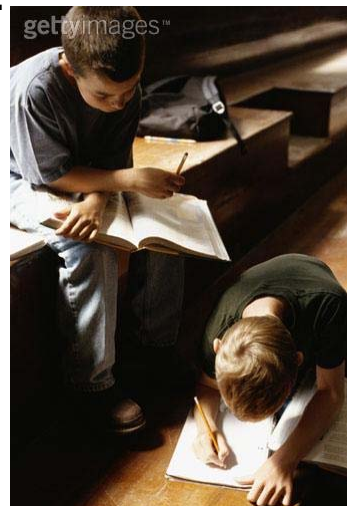
We have designed courses to fit most schools' needs and if you take only one course, your school will still save money by becoming a member of OIEB.

European School Linking Projects – Comenius

Funded by the British Council, the Comenius programme offers substantial grants to support multi-lateral school linking projects. Three or more European partner schools working collaboratively on a curriculum project where there is direct communication between young people. The majority of the funding must be used for mobility between schools and there is additional funding for your people's mobility. The funding covers two years.

The Comenius Project Course run by the OIEB aims to support you through the whole process: from partner finding, through forming a project and applying for funding, to making the most of your project and supporting you with reporting and dissemination. All while your project takes shape and gets off the ground!

Teachers International Professional Development & Study Visits

Funded by the DCSF and LECT (League for the Exchange of Commonwealth Teachers) Teachers International Professional Development takes the form of Action Research opportunities overseas. Typically for a week, participants visit schools and organisations overseas in order to investigate a particular theme.

Visits during Academic Year 08/09 included USA Michigan: Maths ICT & AfL; India Mumbai: Maths, ICT & AfL; Latvia Riga: Creativity in the Curriculum; Russia St Petersburg: Vocational Education & Training; Canada Toronto: Cultural Diversity & Migrants. All International flights and transfers are covered and accommodation is covered on a bed and breakfast twin-share basis.
