

**Oxfordshire's Local Area Agreement
Annual self assessment report 2006/07**

Introduction

We have six monthly review meetings with the Government Office of the South East. These meetings are held to review our performance and discuss areas of risk and actions to address them. Now that we are twelve months into the three year LAA this is a good opportunity to get an accurate picture of where we are doing well and where we need to improve.

We submit a performance report in advance of these meetings. GOSE prepares six monthly headline reports for the Department for Communities and Local Government.

This is our second review meeting and first annual review with GOSE. It is on Thursday 21st June and will involve the LAA Central Team, Block leads, the Chairman of the PSB and representatives from GOSE.

The attached performance report will be submitted to GOSE following agreement at this meeting. It is intended to stimulate an open and constructive discussion on our performance in the first year and focus on areas where further work is required in order to achieve our targets.
