

CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE'S PLAN 2010-13

Summary of Key Issues:

The OCYPT is asked to comment on and agree the attached draft Children and Young People's Plan (CYPP) for public consultation in October

Background

Oxfordshire's current Children and Young People's Plan is due to finish at the end of 2009.

New statutory guidance for CYPPs was published by the DCSF earlier this year and confirmed that this plan will be the key statutory plan for Oxfordshire Children and Young People's Trust Board.

Since the beginning of the year we have been working on the development of this new plan and the key priorities were agreed by the trust in May.

The plan is supported by a detailed needs analysis and action plan. Each 'key objective' mentioned in the plan will have a line in the action plan setting out the outcomes we want to achieve, the actions we will take, who is accountable for delivery and how each activity relates to the Every Child Matters outcomes.

Partner Engagement

Detailed input has been received from the police, PCT, voluntary sector and some district councils. All will have a further chance to input at the Board meeting in September and during formal consultation.

Timeline

Key milestones are:

OCYPT meet and agree draft for consultation	25 September
Formal consultation	1-30 Oct
Consultation analysis	First 2 weeks of November
Final draft	3 rd week of November
Final draft considered and agreed by CYPF DLT	4 th week of November

Oxfordshire Partnership meet	26November
OCYPT meet and formally sign off the plan and action plan	15 January
Plan, action plan and needs analysis is published	Last week of January
Response to consultation published	End of January

All Partner organisations must take the plan through their own governance arrangements in advance of final sign off by the Trust in January.
