

## Circular Walk: Shotover No. I

Routes of approx. 2, 2.4 and 4.8 miles (3, 4 and 8 km)





For Shotover Country Park entrance (1 mile to entrance):
When you reach metal kissing gate, go through to wide dirt track and TP along this track to car park PL across car park to the

and **TR** along this track to car park. **BL** across car park to the entrance to Shotover Country Park. There are three different coloured coded and signposted walks that you can do around the park, that range from 30 to 90 minutes and pass through a variety of habitats including the ancient woodland of Brasenose Woods. There are also a range of bridleways and other paths through the park.

## FOR 2 For Shotover House (2.4 miles to house):

At end of path pass through kissing gate and TL onto Shotover Plain. This was once the old Oxford-to-London stagecoach route. Follow the track for  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile.

(For Shotover Estate)
A little way after joining tarmac road, TL through large wooden gates and continue along treelined avenue. At end of avenue follow the track to the right.
Where road forks, BL to view of the wide estate and landscaped parkland with grazing livestock stretching out around it. If you wish you can walk along the drive through the grounds as far as the A40.

You will soon see the nature reserve on your right. There is a map at the entrance to the nature reserve and you can do a nice loop around the reserve passing by the small lakes.
