



HOW TO GET TO ABBEY MEADOWS

MAP: OS Landranger 164, grid ref SU501971

ROAD: Download free map from www.streetmap.co.uk - insert grid ref above as a Landranger and click SEARCH. Abbey Close car park.

BUS: Stop on Bridge Street, grid ref SU499969. 330m to start of path on pavement and 90m section of narrow access road. To Wantage via Didcot: Regular service 32, not accessible.

Stop on Ock Street, grid ref SU496970. 535m to start of path on pavement and 90m section of narrow access road. To Oxford: Regular services X3 and X4, accessible. Regular services 35 and 35a, not accessible.

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

START from far end of car park:

- Turn right and cross stream
- Turn left and follow path next to stream
- At bridge over stream return along same route to FINISH
