Here's how it works . . .

- Inside the recycling centre you will find marked bays for different types of household waste.
- Park at the first bay you need, switch off your engine and apply your handbrake.
- Carefully put your waste in the right place. With your help we are aiming to recycle over 65% of everything you bring.
- Return to your vehicle and drive through the one-way system, stopping at any other areas you need.
- This site can accept asbestos. Please call 08450 50 45 50 before you take it to the site for more information.

You can recycle all the items listed below:

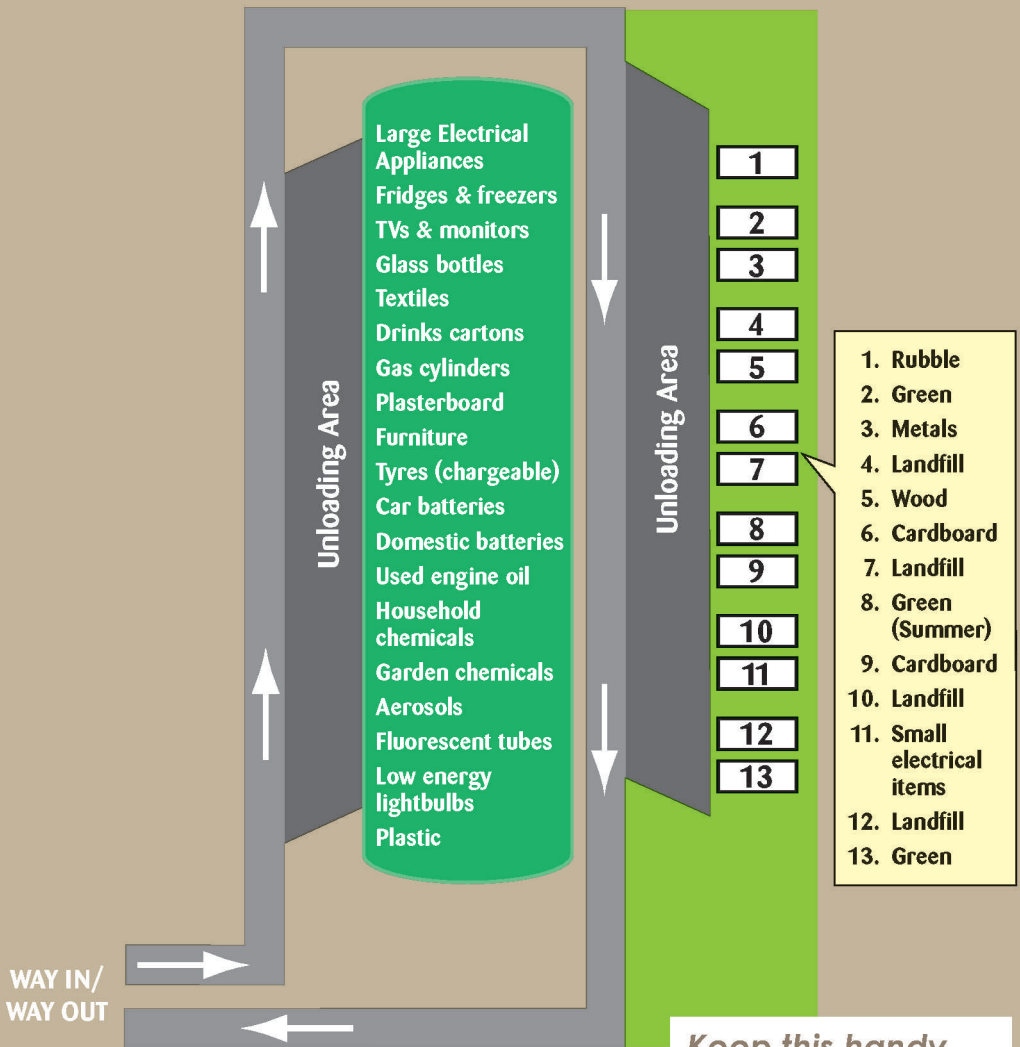


foil, food & drink cans, glass bottles & jars, textiles & shoes, fluorescent tubes & low-energy bulbs, domestic batteries, car batteries, used engine oil, tyres, fridges & freezers, gas bottles, electrical appliances, TVs & monitors, paper & cardboard, green garden waste, scrap metal, soil & hardcore, wood & timber, furniture & plasterboard (household only).

This site is for household waste.

The landfill next door can accept some forms of commercial waste, please leave the WRC and speak to the weighbridge operator or call 08450 50 45 50 for more information.
