What can I borrow?

- Up to 20 books
- 5 music CDs
- 5 DVDs
- 5 audio books

Books are free to borrow. DVDs, CDs and audio books may be hired

How long for?

- Books and talking books may be borrowed for three weeks
- DVDs and music CDs may be hired by the week

You may return anything you have borrowed or hired to any Oxfordshire library

Can I keep them longer?

You may renew your books

- By calling our 24 hour renewals hotline **0845 1202811**. You will need your PIN number
- Online at **www.libcat.oxfordshire.gov.uk** (go to Borrower Services). You will need your PIN number
- By phoning or visiting the library

How do I find what I want?

- Our catalogue is online at **www.libcat.oxfordshire.gov.uk**
- You can check the catalogue at home or in the library. It will tell you what we have in stock, what's available on the shelves and where you'll find everything



Can't find what you want?

- You can reserve books in person, or online with your PIN number
- We can get almost any book from anywhere, so if what you want is not in stock, please ask

How do I get a PIN?

- Ask at any library and present your library card
- If you join online, you choose your own PIN number
- To protect your personal data, PINs are not issued by phone or email

- We have fast free internet access
- Use the online reference library at home or in the library. Log on at **www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/referenceonline**
- We have newspapers and magazines in most libraries
- Ask us anything - we can help you find information on any subject
