

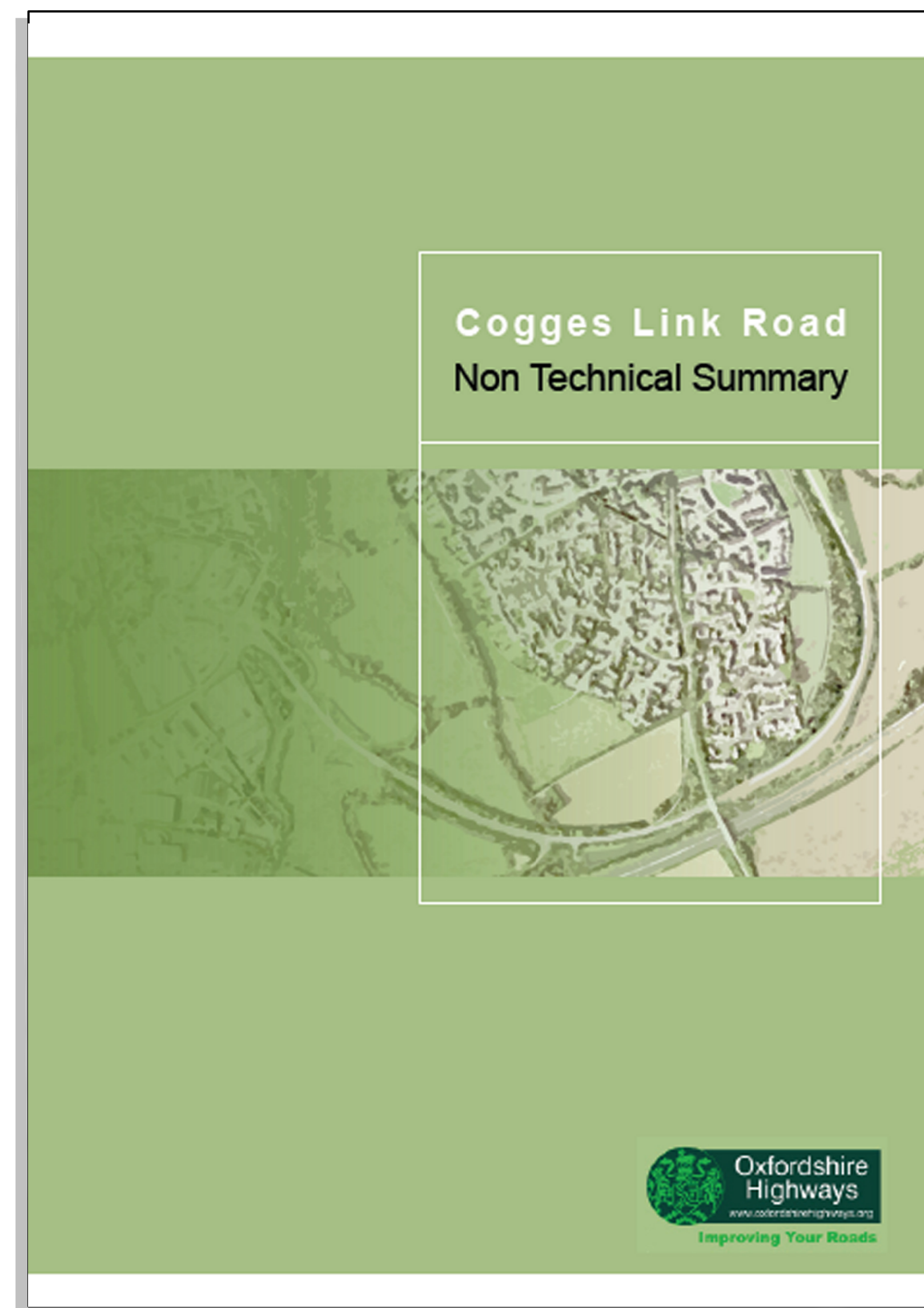
What Happens Next?

All comments on the planning application received by Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) before the 28th November will be collated and form part of a report submitted to the Planning and Regulation Committee. The Planning and Regulation Committee will decide whether or not to grant planning permission for the scheme. The Committee is open to the public and is expected to take place in January 2009, in County Hall, New Road, Oxford.

A Side Roads Order will be published by OCC to authorise alterations to existing roads, footpaths and points of access. A Compulsory Purchase Order would also be published for land required for the scheme.

These orders are normally determined by the Secretary of State who may choose to call a Public Inquiry or not, depending on the nature of any objections received to the published orders.

If a Public Inquiry is called and is successful, it is hoped that construction activities will start at the beginning of 2010. If there is no Public Inquiry construction could start earlier.
