## **When and where can I travel?**

---

The service is available between 9:00am and 5:00pm as follows:

## **What's new?**

---

Octabus dial-a-ride is now available on a first-come-first-served 'open' basis every day it operates. The previous 'localised' pattern of service, whereby various groups of parishes were served on set days of the week has now been dropped. Now you can travel anywhere to anywhere within each District Council area (and beyond on certain days – see details below). All travel is offered subject to vehicle availability.

From 1 April 2006 travel by Octabus is FREE\* for holders of concessionary bus passes. \*certain exceptions apply for some cross-boundary journeys.

## **VALE OF WHITE HORSE DISTRICT**

**Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday** – open service allowing journeys within the Vale of White Horse District Council area, or to Oxford City.

**Thursday and Friday** – open service allowing journeys not catered for on Monday to Wednesday. Journeys will be available to any destination within the Vale of White Horse or West Oxfordshire District Council areas, to Oxford City, and (from Abingdon area only) to Didcot.

## **WEST OXFORDSHIRE DISTRICT**

**Monday to Thursday** – open service allowing journeys within the West Oxfordshire District Council area, or to Oxford City.

**Friday** – open service allowing journeys not catered for on other days, to any destination within West Oxfordshire District Council area, Vale of White Horse area, or to Oxford City.

## **OXFORD CITY**

**Monday – Friday** journeys anywhere within Oxford City.

## What is OCTABUS dial-a-ride?

---

Octabus Dial-a-Ride is a door-to-door service for those who are unable to use or find it difficult to use public transport, such as elderly or disabled people. The drivers of the vehicles are trained both in first aid and in the assistance of wheelchair users and those with mobility problems.

## Whatever your journey purpose\*, Octabus Dial-a-Ride is available to take you!

\*The only exceptions are for journeys to hospitals for appointments, and to social centres operated by Oxfordshire County Council. For hospital appointments please speak to your doctor about travel schemes to enable you to make your appointment. Please speak to Social Services about getting to Oxfordshire County Council-run social centres.

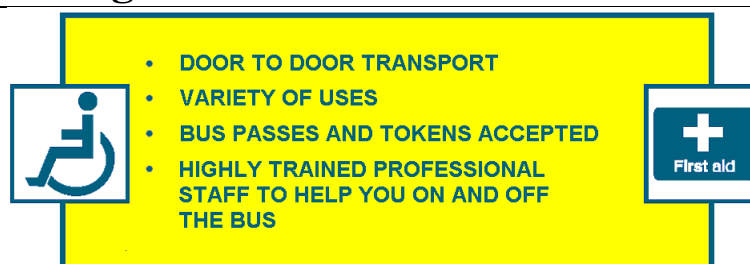
## How do I qualify to use OCTABUS dial-a-ride?

---

- You must live in the area served by the Vale of White Horse District Council, or Oxford City Council, or West Oxfordshire District Council.
- You must be unable to use other forms of public transport without experiencing some difficulty owing to disability or infirmity.
- Age and nature of disability are irrelevant. If you have no other easy access to transport, then you will qualify.

## **How much will it cost?**

---

There is a charge of £5 per person for Membership, but this includes vouchers for two FREE single journeys! No membership is required for those escorting elderly or disabled people, and escorts travel FREE.

**Fares:** for any journey within Vale of White Horse or West Oxfordshire District Council areas or from within either District Council area to and from Oxford City Centre: **£2.00 single or £4.00 return. FREE for concessionary pass holders!**

Vale of White Horse concessionary bus passes are accepted for journeys within the Vale of White Horse District or for journeys to and from Oxford city centre, or to Witney and (from Abingdon area only) to Didcot.

West Oxfordshire concessionary bus passes are accepted for journeys within West Oxfordshire District or for journeys to and from Oxford City or Vale of White Horse District, so long as the journey starts or finishes in West Oxfordshire District. Concessionary fare tokens may be used to offset full fares.

For local journeys anywhere within the City of Oxford:  
**£1.50 single or £3.00 return. FREE for concessionary pass holders!**

Oxford City Council concessionary passes are accepted for journeys wholly within the City.

For other journeys not shown above:  
**£3.00 single or £6.00 return. Free travel is not available on these journeys.**

Bookings can be made between 8.30am & 3.00pm up to seven days in advance by ringing 01865 – 876176. Bookings will be taken on a first-come first-served basis and therefore we recommend booking early. Same day booking will be subject to availability.

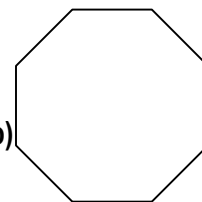
