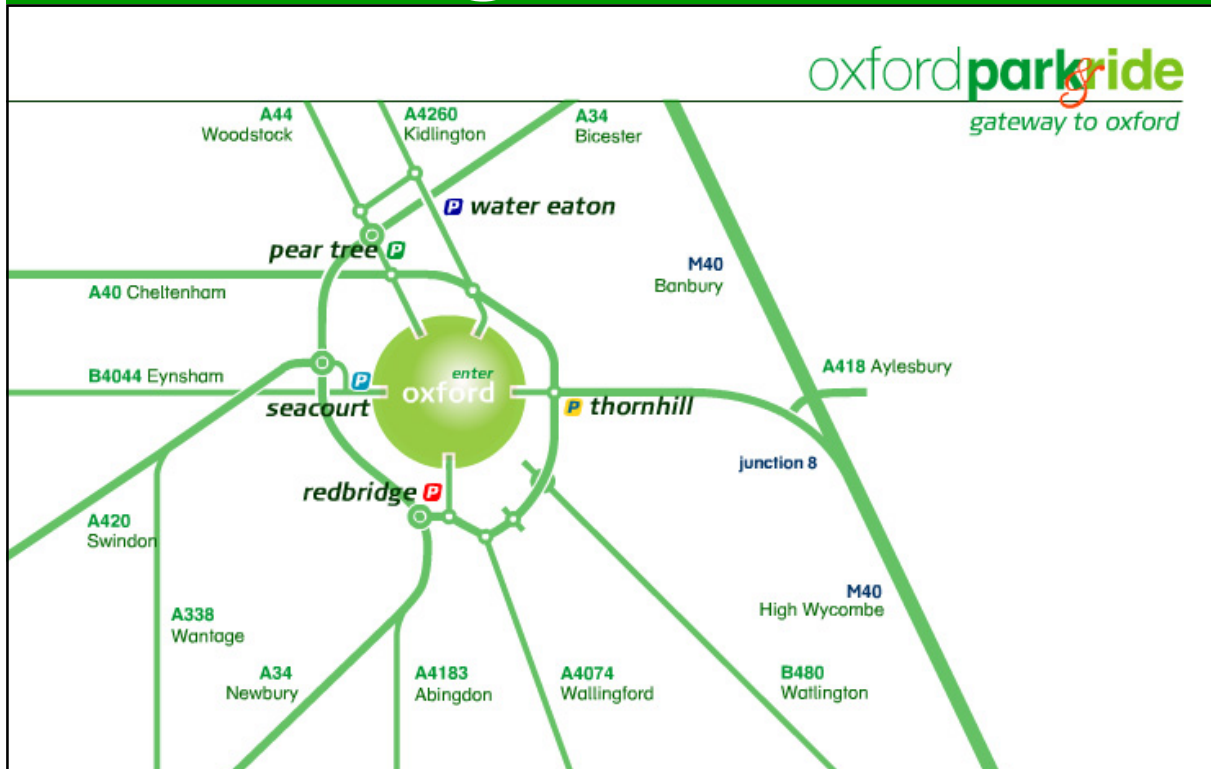


Redbridge Park & Ride



Sat-Nav users enter postcode **OX1 4XG** for Redbridge.

- Park & Ride service 300 to City Centre
- Local services X13 / X23 to John Radcliffe Hospital.
- Local service X3 to Rail Station

- Journey time to city is around 10 minutes.
- Journey times to hospital are around 20-30 minutes
- 1374 car parking spaces in total
- 20 disabled car parking spaces
- Entry height barrier 1.9m, with space for 15 higher sided vehicles available on site.
- Modern waiting room with Real Time info display
- Toilets in waiting room.
- Vending machines in terminal waiting room.
- Free car parking for up to 24 hours.
- All services run 7 days a week
- On site security patrol between 0700 & 2300
- Monday to Friday and until 1700 on Saturday/ Sunday.
