

“Top Ten” Roadworks in Oxfordshire 20th February 2010 – 27th February 2010

- Oxford** **A34 – Wolvercote Viaduct Reconstruction (South of Peartree Interchange)**
Viaduct works – small section of A34 affected. 40mph speed limit along works.
Works by the Highways Agency.
The A34 viaduct works will be ongoing until Summer 2010.
- Oxford** **A40 - Wolvercote Viaduct Reconstruction (Wolvercote R/B to Cassington)**
Pier construction work for A34 viaduct works.
Works by Highways Agency.
Narrow lanes with a reduced speed limit of 30mph for the duration of the works.
- Oxford** **High Street from Turl Street to Long Wall Street**
Kerb replacement and carriageway reconstruction by Oxfordshire County Council.
Temporary 24 hour traffic signals, manually controlled at peak time, with single lane restrictions until 07/02/2010. Closure on Merton Street with diversions until 07/02/2010.
The High Street works will be ongoing until late April 2010.
- Oxford** **Woodstock Road & Banbury Road**
Gas mains works by Southern Gas Networks.
Temporary traffic signals and lane restrictions until 26/04/10.
- Thame** **Oxford Road – from Highfield Close to Priest End**
Gas mains works by Southern Gas Networks.
Temporary traffic signals with lane restrictions until 15/04/10.
- Oxford** **Morrell Avenue, Divinity Road, Stone Street and Union Street**
Electrical works by Scottish and Southern Energy.
Temporary multi-way traffic signals with lane restrictions from 26/01/10 until 01/03/10.
- Henley** **Gravel Hill**
Gas mains works by Southern Gas Networks.
Temporary traffic signals with lane restrictions until 26/04/10.
- Abingdon** **Marcham Road**
Widening carriageway and footway works by Oxfordshire County Council.
Temporary lane restrictions until 01/03/10.
- Banbury** **Cornhill, Market Place, Parson Street**
Carriageway and footway works for pedestrianisation scheme.
Road closures with diversions until 30/06/10.
- Bicester** **King’s End – junction with King’s Avenue**
High voltage supply works by Scottish and Southern Energy.
Temporary lane restrictions until 11/03/10.
