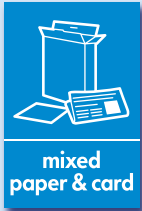
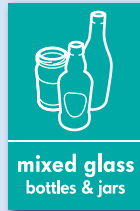

Frequently asked questions

Q. What plastics can I recycle?

A. You can recycle all types of plastic bottles including lids, plastic food pots, tubs, tray and punnets, clingfilm, small amounts of bubble wrap and plant pots. We are unable to accept confectionary wrappers, large plastic items (i.e. plastic swing), children's toys and polystyrene.

Q. Can I recycle plastic bags?

A. Yes, plastic bags can be recycled. However we are unable to accept bags that state, they are biodegradable as they reduce the effectiveness of the recycling process. Please take biodegradable bags back to the supermarket for recycling.

Q. What should I do with recycling that won't fit in the recycling bin?

A. You can place extra recycling neatly at the side of your recycling bin in recycling containers, a cardboard box or a clear plastic bag.

Q. What happens to my recycling?

A. All the recycling is taken to a material reclamation facility at Enstone. The recycling is sorted and then sent on to the relevant reprocessors, where it is used in new products.

Q. Do I need to wash out all my recycling?

A. Yes, items need to be rinsed out. It helps reduce contamination i.e. food waste that gets on paper would result in the paper not being recycled. It also helps reduce smells in your recycling bin, as it is only collected fortnightly.

Q. Where do I present my recycling containers for collection?

A. Please place your container as close to where your property meets the public highway/pavement as possible. Please ensure you do not completely obstruct the pavement when presenting your container.
