



Tyre Recycling

If you need new tyres the garage fitting them should take the old ones for recycling (they may make a charge). If you change your tyres yourself you may bring the old tyres to Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs) for a small charge.

Charges:

-  Householders can take up to 5 car or motorbike tyres to a HWRC in any one visit, at a cost of £2.50 per tyre. Visits to deposit tyres are limited to two per year.
-  Tyres from a push bike will be accepted free of charge. They should be separated from the main frame. Up to a maximum of five bicycle tyres may be deposited a month.

Terms and conditions:

-  Car or motorcycle tyres with a hub rim of over 20 inches diameter will not be accepted.
-  HWRCs will not accept tyres from businesses or any commercial type tyres.
-  Tyres must be deposited in the designated area. Please ask site staff for assistance.
