

# Recycling and Waste Collections in Vale of White Horse



Recycling and waste will be collected from just within the boundary of your property (unless you live down a private lane/farm track). Please leave your bins where they can be seen by the collection crew by 7am on the day of collection.

## **Food waste: Weekly** **Green food waste bin:**

- 🔄 For all raw and cooked food waste, including leftovers and spoiled food. Food waste is collected and taken for composting.

## **Recycling: Every other week** **Green wheeled bin:**

- 🔄 Paper and cardboard;
- 🔄 Food, drink and aerosol cans (steel and aluminum);
- 🔄 Household plastic packaging (including food trays, yoghurt pots, drink bottles and shopping bags);
- 🔄 Food and drink cartons (Tetra Pak);
- 🔄 Glass bottles and jars.

Please wash and squash items and remove tops from plastic bottles to create more space in your recycling bin. Bottle tops can still be placed in recycling bin.

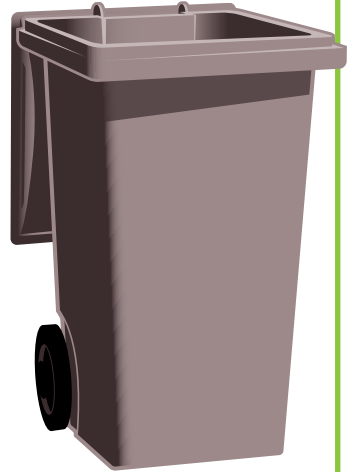
## **Refuse: Every other week**

### **Grey wheeled bin.**

- ◆ polystyrene
- ◆ cling film
- ◆ crisps packets
- ◆ confectionary wrappers
- ◆ disposable nappies
- ◆ sanitary products
- ◆ animal litter

All waste from the grey bin goes to landfill. Please try to reduce your waste by reusing, recycling and composting as much as possible to help save the environment.

## **Garden waste: Collected every other week on the same day as your recycling bin.**

### **Brown wheeled bin.**

For a small annual fee the council provides a garden waste collection.

We will collect garden waste such as grass cuttings, branches, leaves, weeds and hedge clippings. This gets composted locally and used to improve local farmland.

If you have difficulties putting out your recycling and waste due to a disability, illness or physical impairment and there is no one else to help you put it out, we will make alternative arrangements to help you.

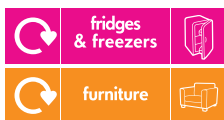





























# Recycling banks in The Vale
